Tournament Rules & Regulations

- 1. **Eligibility**: Players must be at least turning 12 years old in 2024.
- **2.** Entry \$50 per player per division, paid at the Tennis Office on or before entry deadline. Late Entry \$60, paid at sign-in \$60.
- **3.** TennisTT registration of \$65.00 for 2024 is required.
- **4.** <u>Sign-in</u>: All players are required to be at the venue for Sign-in at the times given below:

Open D: Singles - Friday Evening Session - Sign-in between 5:00 -5:30pm
Open C: Singles - Saturday Afternoon Session - Sign-in between 2:00-2:30pm
Open B/C: Singles - Saturday Evening Session - Sign-in between 5:00-5:30pm
Open A/B: Singles - Sunday Noon Session - Sign-in between 11:00-11:30pm
Open A: Singles - Sunday Afternoon Session - Sign-in between 2:00-2:30pm

Draws will be made immediately after sign-in. Due to limited space, players who have completed their entry with payments will be accepted first into the tournament and in the order of completion of their payments. Players not showing for sign-in may be replaces by an onsite alternate who can enter and pay at sign-in.

The Match Play Director:

- 1. May use at his discretion, 2 Wild Card direct entries into the tournament
- 2. Reserves the right to refuse entry into the tournament or particular division
- 5. **Venue:** The National Racquet Centre.

6. **Format**:

Round Robin Phase (RR)

Players will be places into 4 groups (G1, G3, G4 & G4) of a maximum of 4 players per group. National Rankings will be used to separate only the top 4 accepted players into respective groups. If players do not have a National Ranking, then the Director will draw the top 4 players into respective groups at this discretion based on knowledge of the players. Note that all other players will be drawn randomly into respective groups. Each group will play a RR amongst themselves. All matches will be played in a tie-break style, but points will be played continuously for 10-minutes without any targeted end score. At the end of 10-minutes, the players' scores/points will be recorded. If after 10 minutes the scores are tied, then a sudden death point will be played to break the tie (the receiver will choose whether they will receive on the deuce or add side). Players within each group will be ranked [1st, 2nd, 3rd & 4th] according to their total points earned at the end of the RR phase. If there is a tie at the end of the RR phase, then the tie will be broken using head-to-head results.

Knock-out Phase (KO)

The 1st ranked player in each group will be placed into the semi-final of the

Tier 1 KO draw.

The 2nd ranked player in each group will be placed into the semi-final of the Tier 2 KO draw.

The 3rd ranked player in each group will be placed into the semi-final of the Tier 3 KO draw.

The 4th ranked player in each group will be placed into the semi-final of the Tier 4 KO draw.

All semi-finals in each Tier will be played as follows:

- G1 vs G3 & G2 vs G4
- 15 minutes

All finals will be 15 minutes long.

7. Rules:

- There will be a 3-minute break between matches during the RR and KO Phases, a 10-minute break between the RR and KO phase.
- Players can enter as many divisions as applicable, however, due to the limited draw sizes available, every effort will be made to ensure that each player is accepted into at least one of the divisions

8. Prizes:

Medals will be awarded to each Tier Winner.

9. Proper tennis attire is to be worn at all times. Participants are required to come prepared to play with their towels and beverages.
