Goal of this Interclub Tournament

- To re-energize clubs' pride among its membership.
- To foster camaraderie among clubs across Trinidad and Tobago.
- To provide healthy competition for active club members.

Tournament Rules & Regulations

Tournament Format

1. The National Interclub League will consist of 3 Divisions, the Premiere Division, Championship Division and the Challenger Division
2. The Premiere League is open to all levels of players, while the Championship League cannot include any "A" rated players and the Challenger League cannot contain any A or B rated players on the team.
3. The tournament will adopt a Round Robin Format
4. Players will only be eligible to compete for one club and in one league.
5. Each club may enter no more than two (2) team per category unless otherwise approved by the committee.
6. Clubs must submit the names of each player on the team.
7. Each **Club Representative** must submit their official Application Form (see attached form) to the National Association via email by January 31st at 12pm.
8. Each Club Representative is invited to the Official Draw which will take place at the National Racquet Centre on Feb 1st at 6pm. All player's ratings will be reviewed and approved by the Tournament Committee.
9. Each team is required to register their team consisting of maximum of 20 players with at least one female and one veteran (45+) player. One player can be registered under 2 categories but only be declared under one category within a tie.
10. Players 45+ must be at least turning the age of 45 on the year of the tournament.
11. 45+ players can be male or female
12. Players must be at least 13 years old at the starting date of the tournament.
13. Players may be asked to show proof of age eligibility.
14. Each team may also register as many reserves as they desire by the entry deadline.
15. Teams are encouraged to register enough players/reserves to ensure availability of their players to play the published schedule.
16. Teams are responsible for providing their own refreshments.
17. Teams are to consult with the tournament schedule for match dates and times.
18. Matches may be played during the weekdays starting 5pm or on weekends starting 9am.

19. All matches will be played at the National Racquet Centre unless otherwise decided by the committee.

Tie Format

1. Each tie consists of a female combined doubles (i.e. one player must be female), a 45+ combined doubles (i.e. one player must be 45+) and an open singles.
2. Each team must declare five (5) individual players per tie. No substitutions during tie.
3. Each game won will add to team's total points. The winner will be the team that has the most points at the end of the tournament.
4. In the event of a tie, head-to-head results will be used to break the tie.
5. Each match will be played as follows:
 - a. Each Rubber will be a total of 12 games
 - b. Each Tie will consist of a total of 36 games
 - c. No advantage scoring (Sudden Death)
6. Depending on the number of teams entered, divisions may have a Round Robin phase then a knock-out phase.
7. In the event of a tie at the end of the Round Robin Phase or Knock-out rounds, teams will draw to see which rubber will play a match tie-break to break the tie. Teams are able to nominate any of their registered members to play the deciding match tie-break.
8. Coaching of fellow team members is allowed on changeovers by a designated person.
9. Teams are to report to the site of competition at their scheduled time of play.
10. Defaults of teams may occur if a team fails to report to the site of competition within 30 minutes of the predetermined match start time.
11. If only a portion of the team reports to the site within the stipulated time, these team members will be allowed to compete in the tie.
- 12. The committee reserves the right to amend the format after entry deadline.**
13. Unless otherwise stated here, all rules as prescribed by the ITF applies.
14. Each club to be represented in their club colours.

Registration Criteria

1. Each club must have paid their TATT yearly subscription of \$500.00
2. Each team member must have paid their TATT yearly registration of \$65.00
3. Each team member must pay a tournament registration fee of \$50.00.
